Springfield Boys & Girls Club After School Day Care

The Springfield Boys & Girls Club After School Program is licensed by the Office of Child Care Services and provides programs and activities to youths from ages 6 to 13 while their parents are working or attending school.

The program operates year round. During the school year the program is open Monday - Friday from 3:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. During summer and school vacation weeks and holidays (holidays open/closed are listed below) the program is open from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Transportation is available.

The program also closes for 2 weeks at the end of August in order to prepare for the beginning of the new school year.

Snow Day Policy

On Snow Days, if the public schools in Springfield, West Springfield, Chicopee, or Westfield are closed due to inclement weather, there will be a two hour delay for transportation. If any of the public schools listed in those towns above remain open, the children in those towns will receive transportation. If there is a declared state of emergency, all transportation is halted and parents will be notified to pick up their children as soon as possible. If there is a public school delay of one to two hours, day care transportation will also be delayed. All cancellations and or delays will be advertised on all the Clear TV and WMAS Radio AM/FM.



Pick -Up Policy

When picking up your child from the program you are required to sign him/her out on a daily sign-out sheet along with recording the time you leave. No child will be allowed to leave the program with a person who is not listed on his/her registration form. Parents must notify the program of anyone who is not listed who will be picking up your child. All children must be picked up by the hour closing each day. Parents will be charged \$10 per hour for each hour past 6:00 p.m.

Policy For Providing Lunch/Snacks

Snacks will be provided during the school year to youth enrolled in the Springfield Boys & Girls Club School Aged After School Program. Lunch will be provided to youth only during the summer hours of the program. It is the parent's responsibility to provide a nutritious snack and lunch during program hours that operate during school vacations and holidays that fall during the school year. Parents are also responsible for providing a lunch and snack in the event the school closes for early dismissal.
